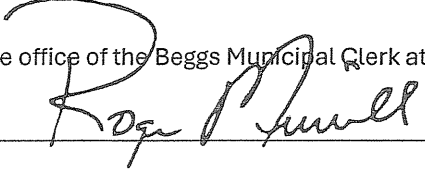

City Council will consider, discuss, vote to approve, or disapprove to table or take no action on the following items:

1. **Discussion and Possible Action:** Regarding the status of the City's FY 2027 budget, which was not adopted prior to the start of the fiscal year on July 1, 2026, and any corrective or interim action necessary
2. **Approve/disapprove:** Resolution 2026-05 regarding restricting expenditures during the interim period of an unadopted budget for FY 2027
3. **Discussion and Possible Action:** Regarding the authorization of Beggs Police Department personnel and vehicles for use by a production company for filming/street closure purposes.
4. **Approve/disapprove:** Vote to enter Executive Session to discuss the following separately identified matters:
 - (a) Pursuant to 25 O.S. § 307(B)(4) (confidential communications with the City Attorney concerning a pending investigation and claim) and 25 O.S. § 307(B)(1) (discussing the employment, disciplining, or potential administrative leave of the Chief of Police and Assistant Chief of Police), to discuss a pending Police Department personnel complaint and investigation;
 - (b) Pursuant to 25 O.S. § 307(B)(1), to discuss the employment/performance of City Administrator, a matter separate and unrelated to subpart (a);
 - (c) Pursuant to 25 O.S. § 307(B)(4), for confidential communications with the City Attorney regarding Okmulgee Co. District Court Case No. CJ-2026-00093, *C4L, LLC v. City of Beggs*, where disclosure would seriously impair the City's ability to conduct the litigation/claim in the public interest.
5. **Approve/disapprove:** Vote to Exit Executive Session and Return to Open Session
6. **Discussion and Possible Action :** Regarding matters discussed in Executive Session the following identified matters:

- a) Session (Item 3(a), including possible vote to authorize engagement of an independent, outside investigator to conduct the pending personnel investigation, and approval of an associated expense not to exceed \$[amount].
- b) Session Item 3(b) concerning City Administrator, including any vote on employment status, discipline, or related action.
- c) Session Item 3(c) concerning Okmulgee Co. District Court Case No. CJ-2026-00093, *C4L, LLC v. City of Beggs*, including any vote on settlement authority, direction to counsel, or related action.
